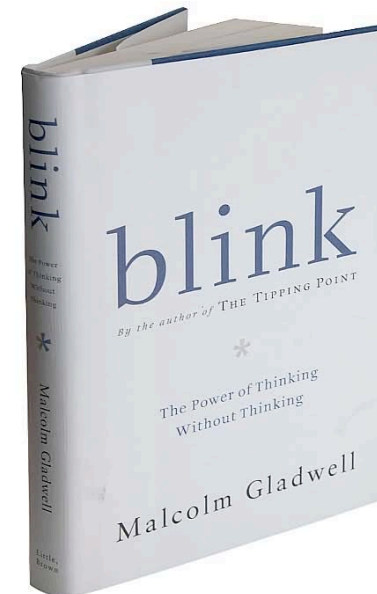
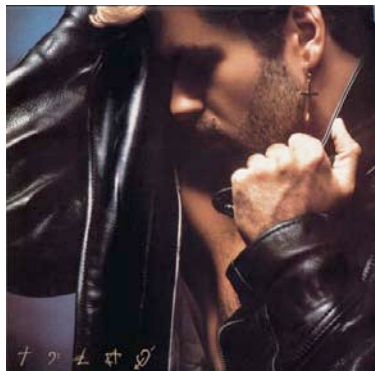



Sample answer:

- ➔ Freud: ritual and neurosis
- ➔ Snowperson repeatedly tries to escape
- ➔ Avoids challenge of how to live in his home
- ➔ Becomes frustrated and unhappy
- ➔ Meaning: find happiness on your own, don't look outside yourself
